### Up in the sky

We can see the sun, the moon and the stars in the sky.

### The Sun

The sun shines during the day. It is far away from us. It looks like a big round hot ball of fire. It gives us heat and light. It is also the source of energy. It brings us a new day in the morning. When it rises. Every morning, the sun rises in the east and every evening, the sun sets in the west. The sun helps living things to live. It helps them to grow.

### The Moon

# Many Shapes of the Moon

### The Stars

There are many twinkling stars in the sky, too. Stars cannot be seen in the day time. Stars are very big. They look small because of their large distance from the earth. The sun is also a star.
